the acclaimed travel writer journeys by train across the americas from boston to patagonia in this international bestselling travel memoir starting with a rush hour subway ride to south station in boston to catch the lake shore limited to chicago paul theroux takes a grand railway adventure first across the united states and then south through mexico central america and across the andes until he winds up on

the meandering old patagonian express steam engine his epic commute finally comes to a halt in a desolate land of cracked hills and thorn bushes that reaches toward antarctica along the way theroux demonstrates how train travel can reveal the social miseries and scenic splendors of a continent and through his perceptive prose we learn that what matters most are the people he meets along the way including the monologuing mr thornberry in costa rica the bogus priest of cali and the blind jorge luis borges who delights in having theroux read robert louis stevenson to him

in this unique and hugely entertaining railway odyssey theroux vividly recounts his travels and the people places and landscapes he encountered on the orient express the khyber mail and the trans siberian express through such countries as turkey iran india southeast asia japan and the soviet union

a book about the meaning of travel about how important the topic has been for writers for two and a half centuries and about how excellent the literature of travel happened to be in england and america in the 1920s and 30s

spanning four seasons 10 countries and three teaching jobs this memoir chronicles mccahill s solo journey from guatemala to argentina in her struggles with language romance culture service and homesickness she personifies a growing culture of women for whom travel is not a path to love but a route to meaningful work rare inspiration and profound self discovery

in ghost train to the eastern star theroux recreates an epic journey he took thirty years ago a giant loop by train mostly through eastern europe turkey the caucasus central asia the indian subcontinent china japan and siberia in short he traverses all of asia top to bottom and end to end in the three decades since he first travelled this route asia has undergone phenomenal change the soviet union has collapsed china has risen india booms burma slowly smothers and vietnam prospers despite the havoc unleashed upon it the last time theroux passed through he witnesses all this and more in a 25 000 mile journey travelling as the locals do by train car bus and foot his odyssey takes him from eastern europe still hungover from communism through tense but thriving turkey into the caucasus where georgia limps back toward feudalism while its neighbour azerbaijan revels in oil driven capitalism as he penetrates deeper into asia s heart his encounters take on an otherworldly cast the two chapters that follow show us turkmenistan a profoundly isolated society at the mercy of an almost comically egotistical dictator and uzbekistan a ruthless authoritarian state from there he retraces his steps through india mayanmar china and japan providing his penetrating observations on the changes these countries have undergone brilliant caustic and totally addictive ghost train to the eastern star is theroux at his very best

it was 1982 the summer of the falkland islands war and the birth of the royal heir prince william and the ideal time theroux found to surprise the british into talking about themselves the result is a candid funny perceptive and opinionated travelogue of his journey and his findings

patagonia is a strange and terrifying place a vast tract of land shared by argentina and chile where the violent weather spawned over the southern pacific charges through the andes with gale force winds roaring clouds and stinging snow squarely athwart the latitudes known to sailors as the roaring forties and furious fifties patagonia is a land trapped between angry torrents of sea and sky a place that has fascinated explorers and writers for centuries magellan discovered the strait that bears his name during the first circumnavigation charles darwin traveled patagonia s windy steppes and explored the fjords of tierra del fuego during the voyage of the beagle from the novel perspective of the cockpit antoine de saint exupry immortalized the andes in wind sand and stars and a half century later bruce chatwin s in patagonia earned a permanent place among the great works of travel literature yet even today the patagonian andes remain mysterious and remote a place where horrible storms and ruthless landscapes discourage all but the most devoted pilgrims from paying tribute to the daunting and dangerous peaks gregory crouch is one such pilgrim in seven expeditions to this windswept edge of the southern hemisphere he has braved weather gravity fear and doubt to try himself in the alpine crucible of patagonia crouch has had several notable successes including the first winter ascent of the legendary cerro torre s west face to go along with his many spectacular failures in language both stirring and lyrical he evokes the perils of every handhold perils that illustrate the crucial balance between physical danger and mental agility that allows for the most important part of any climb which is not reaching the summit but getting down alive crouch reveals the flip side of cutting edge alpinism the stunning variety of menial labor one must often perform to afford the next expedition from building sewer systems during a bitter colorado winter to washing the plastic balls in mcdonalds playgrounds crouch s dedication to the alpine craft has seen him through as many low moments as high summits he recounts too the riotous celebrations of successful climbs the numbing boredom of forced encampments and the quiet pride that comes from knowing that one has performed well and bravely even in failure included are more than two dozen color photographs that capture the many moods of this land from the sublime beauty of the mountains at sunrise to the unrelenting fury of its storms enduring patagonia is a breathtaking odyssey through one of the world s last wild places a land that requires great sacrifice but offers great rewards to those who dare to challenge it

in 1906 when the creek indian chitto harjo was protesting the united states government s liquidation of his tribe s lands he began his argument with an account of indian history from the time of columbus for of course a thing has to have a root before it can grow yet even today most intelligent non indian americans have little knowledge of indian history and affairs those lessons have not taken root this book is an in depth historical survey of the indians of the united states including the eskimos and aleuts of alaska which isolates and analyzes the problems which have beset these people since their first contacts with europeans only in the light of this knowledge the author points out can an intelligent indian policy be formulated in the book are described the first meetings of indians with explorers the dispossession of

the indians by colonial expansion their involvement in imperial rivalries their beginning relations with the new american republic and the ensuing century of war and encroachment the most recent aspects of government indian policy are also detailed the good and bad administrative practices and measures to which the indians have been subjected and their present situation miss debo s style is objective and throughout the book the distinct social environment of the indians is emphasized an environment that is foreign to the experience of most white men through ignorance of that culture and life style the results of non indian policy toward indians have been centuries of blundering and tragedy in response to indian history an enlightened policy must be formulated protection of indian land vocational and educational training voluntary relocation encouragement of tribal organization recognition of indians social groupings and reliance on indians abilities to direct their own lives the result of this new policy would be a chance for indians to live now whether on their own land or as adjusted members of white society indian history is usually highly specialized and is never recorded in books of general history this book unifies the many specialized volumes which have been written about their history and culture it has been written not only for persons who work with indians or for students of indian culture but for all americans of good will

about his role in her life yet he has also protected her at times while she fears that he may have followed her to loreburn she fears even more that he may not be able to find her there with the custodian of paradise wayne johnston continues his masterful exploration of life in pre confederation newfoundland and of the powerful forces that give rise to great character individualism circumstance and secrecy memory loss and regret
